ELECTOR & NON RESIDENT ELECTOR REGISTRATION

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. In order to register at the time of voting, you will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- Be 18 years of age or older on general voting day (Saturday, October 15, 2022);
- Be a Canadian citizen;
- Be a resident of BC for at least six (6) months immediately preceding the day of registration;
- Be a resident of the Township of Spallumcheen immediately preceding the day of registration;

- OR be a registered owner of real property in the Township of Spallumcheen for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration;
- not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in the election or otherwise disqualified by law; and
- am entitled to vote and have not previously voted in this election.

Resident electors will also be required to produce **two (2) pieces of identification** (at least one (1) with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must produce **two (2) pieces of identification** (at least one (1) with a signature) to prove identity, **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, produce **written consent** from the majority of property owners. Please note corporations, without a registered owner on title, cannot vote.

MAIL BALLOT APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Mail Ballot Voting Opportunities

Qualified electors may vote by mail if they:

- (a) have a physical disability, illness, or injury that affects their ability to vote at another voting opportunity; or
- (b) expect to be absent from the Township of Spallumcheen on general voting day and at the times of all advance voting opportunities.

Requesting a Mail Ballot Package:

Before 4 pm on October 13, 2022, you must submit the following information to the Municipal office by mail (4144 Spallumcheen Way, Spallumcheen, BC V0E 1B6), telephone (250-546-3013), fax (250-546-8878) or email (mail@spallumcheentwp.bc.ca):

- (1) Full name,
- (2) Residential address,
- (3) Address of the property in relation to which you are voting (for non-resident property electors),
- (4) Method of delivery of your mail ballot package:
 - pick up at the Spallumcheen office, OR
 - regular letter mail through Canada Post to residential address, OR
 - regular letter mail through Canada Post to an alternate address that you provide when requesting the ballot package, and
- (5) indication as to whether you are going to be registering as a resident or non-resident property elector.

A person wishing to vote by mail ballot shall make application during the period commencing **September 28, 2022 and ending at 4:00 pm October 13, 2022** by contacting the Chief Election Officer or Deputy. To be counted, your mail ballot must be received by the Chief Election Officer no later than 8 pm on Saturday, October 15, 2022.
