Location: 4320 Highland Park Road V0E 1B4

Visiting Hours: Sunrise to Sunset

Interment Hours: Not prior to 8:00 am and not after 4:30pm

Plot Information: Refer to the current Cemetery Operations & Maintenance Bylaw

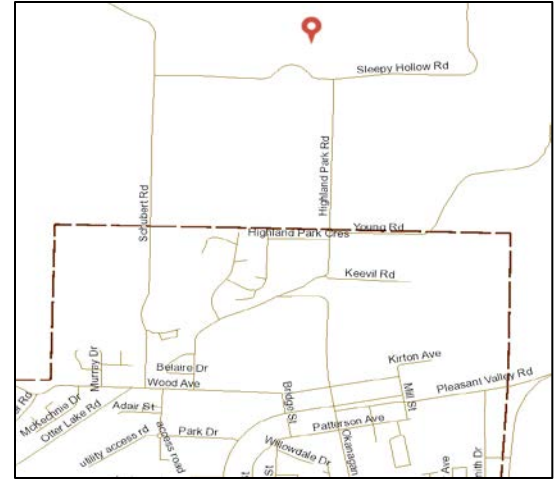
Marker Information: Marker sizes must comply with the following:

Adult Grave: Single: 71.12cm x 30.43cm (28"x12")
Companion: 91.4cm x 30.43cm (36"x12")
(placed *over two plots*)

Height: Upright Memorial Markers – 45.72cm (18")
Raised Memorial Markers – 20.32 cm (8")

Cremation: Single: 30.43cm x 20.32cm (12"x12")

Height: Flat Memorial Markers only – flush with the surrounding ground level



- Any memorial marker that has been delivered to the Cemetery that does not meet the specifications set out in this bylaw will be returned to the company from which it was delivered at the Company's expense after 30 days.
- All grave markers or memorials are the property of the purchaser. All required care, upkeep, and repair is the responsibility of the owner (purchaser).
- All memorial markers to be installed on burial plots shall be made of natural stone or bronze.
- Due to winter conditions, installation of Memorials may not occur from November 1 to April 30. No person shall deliver Memorials to the Cemetery without approval by the Caretaker between November 1 and April 30.
- Only one upright memorial marker may be installed on any adult grave site and that memorial marker must be situated at the head of the grave site.

Number of Interments Per Plot:

Adult Grave Options:

- Six cremation interments;
- **Or** one full burial and up to six cremation interments;
- **Or**, under deeper depth provisions, two full burials and up to four cremation interments.

Cremation Grave:

- Two cremation interments.

Niche:

- Four cremations in standard size urns.



Flowers and Grave Adornment Conditions:

Floral Display

- Only one permanent or continuous display is allowed at the head of each site.
- Must be constructed of rod or bank iron designed as a holder or retainer of a flower vase or other container.
- Must be in an unbreakable vase supported by a vase holder (NO GLASS).
- Maximum height of 25.4 cm (10") above the height of any memorial marker installed at the head of the grave site.

Other Offerings:

- Flowers, wreaths and other offerings may be placed on graves.

Offerings Not Permitted:

- For the integrity and continuity of the Cemetery, other objects of remembrance such as boxes, shells, toys, wire screens, candles, glass, pottery, china, stuffed animals, crosses, picture frames with glass, ceramics, metal objects, food items and lanterns are not permitted.

All items placed on graves may be removed by the Caretaker when their condition is considered by the Caretaker to be detrimental to the appearance of the cemetery or for the purpose of regular maintenance of the cemetery.

The Township will not be held responsible for the condition of live items or lost or stolen items.

General Provisions and Regulations:

No one, at any time, may:

- (a) Plant, remove, cut down or destroy any trees, shrubs, plants, flowers, bulbs or rocks in the cemetery, other than an employee of the Township, caretaker or contractor authorized to do so;
- (b) Damage or deface any memorial, monument, fence, gate, structure or improvements in the cemetery;
- (c) Drive a vehicle in the cemetery at any time at a speed of more than 16 km/h (10 mph) and all vehicles and their drivers, while in the cemetery grounds, shall be subject to the reasonable directions and order of the Caretaker;
- (d) Solicit orders for markers, tablets, memorials, curbing, capping or like works within the limits of the cemetery;
- (e) Discharge any firearms in the cemetery, other than in regular volleys at a burial service;
- (f) Be in the cemetery at any time other than between sunrise and sunset, except with special permission of the Caretaker.
- (g) Burn any incense or candles or other flammables inside the cemetery at any time.
- (h) Consume alcohol, narcotics or other intoxicants at any time.
