Load Restrictions Now in Effect: Help protect our roads during the spring thaw. Please adhere to posted load restrictions.

Street Sweeping Underway: Our public works team is working hard to clear winter debris from the roads. Watch for crews in your area. you prefer to complete the brushing on your property, please notify the Municipal Office to be added to the exemption list.

Line Painting Scheduled for April: Fresh road markings will be applied. Please drive with caution around painting crews.

Gravel Road Maintenance: Our grader will be making multiple passes to keep roads smooth until dust control is applied in May.
