- Eligibility is for producers that have had to move cattle off range, or have lost range or forage to fire. Eligibility is for 14 days unless and extension is approved by Emergency Management BC (EMBC).
- The Province and/or the Local Authority is not liable for any loss, including any loss from injury, sickness, death or reduced production incurred by any feed received through this program.
- Claims may be audited.
- The information collected will be used for administering and evaluating the Emergency Livestock Feed Program. Confidential or personal information is subject to provisions of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*.
