

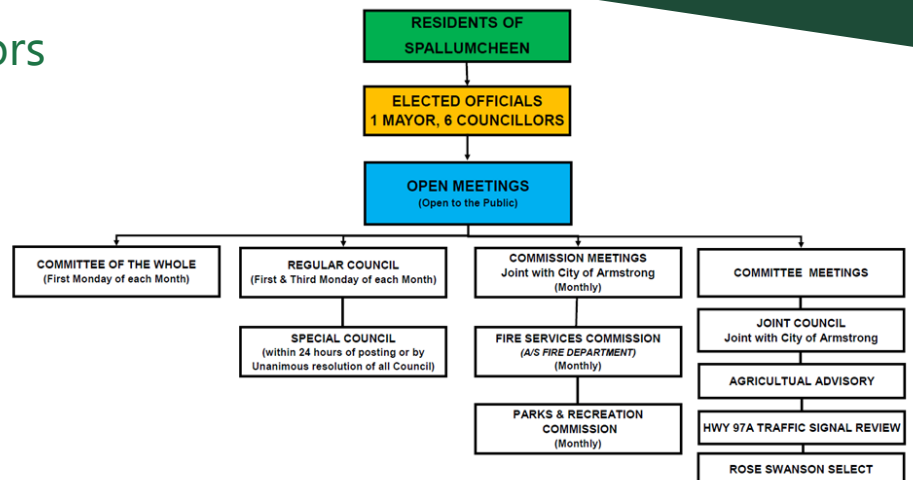
# Municipal Governance



## Who are Council?

Spall has 1 Mayor and 6 Councillors

- Council consists of members of the community or surrounding area with an interest in being involved in decision making for the community.
- Council receives an annual stipend for their involvement in the community dispersed monthly.
- Council enters Oaths of Office at the beginning of their term.



## What does Council do?

- Adopt and review regulation in the form of bylaws and adopt and review policy for the community to abide by.
- Communicate with the province regarding provincial regulations to address any community concerns.
- Provide clear directives to staff regarding priorities – Identify Strategic Community Goals.
- Plan for the community's future – Community Development Plan (CDP).
- Attend Council, Committee of the Whole and Committee meetings.
- Are appointed to liaison with other community groups

### ELECTION:

Held every 4 years with the next occurring October, 2022

Must be held on the 3rd Saturday of October.

To be a candidate you are required to at least 2 nominators from the community which is determined by bylaw.



### COUNCIL LEGISLATION:

Council is governed by legislation including the *Community Charter*, *Local Government Act*, *WorkSafeBC*, *Agricultural Land Reserve Regulations*, *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*.
